

How Community Solar Works



Free State Clean Energy Program

Lower energy costs

1

A solar developer applies to build a project on a commercial rooftop, landfill, or brownfield. Once it is awarded by the state the developer has a year to build the project. 2

The energy is fed into the local utility grid to service adjacent municipalities or counties depending on the application. 3

An interested community member accesses the project through the project's subscription website to receive discounted solar energy.



Subscribers receive a cost savings on the portion of solar credited to their bill


