From North Jersey

Take Garden State Parkway South to exit #114
Homdel/Middletown - go 0.4 mi
Turn Left onto Red Hill Rd (CR-52) – continue to
the end
Turn right onto Kings Hwy - go 0.3 mi
Make second right onto Church St. (CR-50) - go 0.1
mi
The Middletown Arts Center is a large brick build-
ing with green awnings on your left.

From South Jersey

Take Garden State Parkway North to exit #114
Homdel/Middletown - go 0.4 mi
Turn Right onto Red Hill Road, continue to end of
road
Turn right onto Kings Hwy - go 0.3 mi
Make second right onto Church St (CR-50) - go 0.1
mi
Arrive at 36 Church St, on the left

From Highway 35 Southbound

South on RT-35 into Middletown.
Turn Right onto New Monmouth Rd (CR-50) –
(Value City Furniture on Corner.)
Turn Right onto Kings Hwy (CR-50) - go 0.2 mi
Turn Left on Church St (CR-50) - go 0.1 mi
Arrive at 36 Church St, on the left

From Highway 35 Northbound

Take Rte 35 North into Middletown to New Mon-
mouth Rd.
Take the U-turn to cross over Rte 35 and continue
on New Monmouth Rd.
Turn Right on Kings Hwy (CR-50) - go 0.2 mi
Turn Left on Church St (CR-50) - go 0.1 mi
Arrive at 36 Church St, on the left

Free parking is available in the commuter lot across
from the Arts Center.

Or take the train: trains on the NJ Coastline arrive
at the Middletown station which is across the com-
muter parking lot from the Arts Center.
