Instant Discounts Program

About the program

The Instant Discounts Program provides participating HVAC distributors/vendors incentives for selling qualified HVAC equipment to end users or contractors serving end users. Distributors receive incentives from JCP&L, which they pass along to customers/contractors. Instant discounts are available for existing buildings only. New construction projects are not eligible.

HVAC Equipment Instant Discount Requirements

1. Instant Discounts are provided at the distributor/vendor level
2. A customer seeking an incentive for these products must seek out an eligible distributor or contractor who works with an eligible distributor
